*India has a long but less-storied history with alcohol. Historically, tonics featuring a blend of indigenous ingredients were used as medicines, as part of ayurvedic tradition of Anupana centred around the Pitta Dosha; stimulating the digestive fire 'Agni'. Fitting, then, that the custom within Indian high society is to imbibe in aged spirits both before and after meals.*

*British colonial presence in India during the Victorian era played a significant role in shaping a growing drinking culture across the country, bringing a taste for spirits and mixed drinks.*

*No cocktail better exemplifies this history than the "Gin and Tonic," originally developed in India as a way to make quinine (used to treat malaria) more palatable by mixing it with gin and soda water. This drink eventually became a staple of colonial-era cocktail culture in India.*

*Which is exactly why we don't feature one on our list.*

If legends are to be believed, coffee made its way to India by virtue of seven beans smuggled out of Arab-ruled Ethiopia in the 1670s. We use a powerful, spice-driven blend which makes use of hand-harvested and selected Arabica and Robusta beans, grown near Mysore, Karnataka. We recommend enjoying it as an espresso or with a touch of milk as a macchiato.*
